I. God's PROVISION v.11 "Daily Bread"

A. THE **SUBSTANCE** "bread"

Bread represents all of our **physical** needs.

This part of the prayer is a petition, and also an **affirmation** (Ja.1.17).

B. THE **SOURCE** "Father"

Every physical thing we have comes from God's provision - therefore it is a sin of <u>indifference</u> & <u>ingratitude</u> not to daily recognize His gifts in thankful prayer.

C. <u>SUPPLICATION</u> "give"

This is the **heart** of the petition, because it recognizes **need**.

D. THE SEEKERS "us"

The **us** of Jesus' model prayer are those who **belong** to Him.

God irrevocably **commits** Himself to meet the essential needs of His own.

Those problems only aggravate the basic problem, which is **spiritual**.

God's primary way of provision is through work...

His primary way to care for those who cannot work is through the **generosity** of those who are able to work.

E. THE SCHEDULE "daily"

God's provision for His children is **daily**.

- We are to rely on the Lord one day at a time.
- ❖ It is contentment to accept the Lord's present provision without **concern** for our needs tomorrow.

Sin is a moral and spiritual **debt** to God that must be paid.

A. THE PROBLEM "debts"

Sin is that which **separates** man from God,

- The ultimate effects of sin are death & damnation, &
- The <u>present</u> effects are misery, dissatisfaction, & guilt.

Sin is the <u>common</u> denominator of every sin and evil. (Je.13.23) Immeasurably more <u>important</u> than our need for daily bread is our need for <u>continual</u> forgiveness of sin.

B. THE **PROVISION** "forgive us"

Because man's greatest problem is sin, his greatest need is forgiveness

Forgiveness is the central **theme** of this entire passage.

Because we still fall into sin, we frequently require God's gracious forgiveness, His forgiveness not now as Judge but as **Father**.

- > The **positional** purging of salvation that occurs at regeneration needs no repetition,
- > The **practical** purging is needed every day,

CONCLUSION:

As Judge, God is **eager** to forgive sinners;

As Father He is even more eager to keep on forgiving His children.
