Mt.6.19-24 focuses on the attitude toward **luxury**

Mt.6.25-34 focuses on the attitude toward **the necessities of life**

One of the most reliable marks of their **spiritual** condition attitude toward material possessions

One of the supreme tests of our spiritual lives, then, is how we now relate to those two worlds.

The believer’s attitude toward money and possessions is **determinative**.

**Jesus** gives four reasons why worry is wrong:

it is **unfaithful** because of our Master;

it is **unnecessary** because of our Father;

it is **unreasonable** because of our faith;

it is **unwise** because of our future.

### **I. WORRY IS UNFAITHFUL BECAUSE OF OUR MASTER V. 25**

**Therefore, I tell you** [For this reason] refers back to the Christian’s only **Master is God**.

Worry is the sin of distrusting the promise and providence of God,

The **substance** of worry is small compared to the impact on our mind.

Worry is the opposite of contentment,

A Christian’s contentment is found in God, and **only** in God—in His:

**ownership,**

**control,**

**provision**

**First**, God **owns** everything in the entire universe.

**Second**, God **controls** everything.

**Third**, the Lord **provides** everything.

All three of those necessities pertain to the **body**,

Even as Christians we **live** for our bodies.
