2. THE <u>DANGER</u> OF FALSE PROPHETS
Beware always warns of danger – it is a call to be on guard.
Wolves are known for being merciless & ferocious (Ez.22.27) − ravenous = "swindler" (Lk.18.11) Our first need is to get ourselves; right with the Lord,
1st group Jude mentions is composed of <u>believers:</u> ➤ who have been tempted to <u>doubt</u> their faith, & 2nd group is composed of <u>unbelievers:</u> ➤ who need to be <u>grabbed</u> , as it were, 3rd group is composed of those who are confirmed in <u>false religion:</u> ➤ special <u>care</u> is needed & special <u>dependence</u> on the Lord for; ✓ lest we ourselves become spiritually <u>contaminated</u> by their polluted views & ways.
3. THE <u>DECEPTION</u> OF FALSE PROPHETS
When an enemy is seen we are alerted & can be P to defend ourselves. False prophets deceive the flock by impersonating the S , who wears sheep's clothing.
 Heretics are those who openly R the word of God. Apostate teachers are those who O followed the true faith. They do not claim to represent, biblical Christianity. The F S (the deceiver), on the other hand, gives the appearance of orthodoxy
False prophets are almost always P & P They know and use B terminology &
Many false prophets also appear to be S False Teachers frequently show their true colors by what they do N affirm. They simply I "negative" & uncomfortable truths.
False prophets use Jesus Christ & His Gospel & Church as means for serving their own ends One test for a False Teacher in the area of L
A false prophet is always in Church work for H ;
