I. EMULATE the EXAMPLE [A Disciple is Like Jesus] vv.24-25

II. REFUSE to be SILENT [A DISCIPLE DOES NOT FEAR THE WORLD] VV.26-31

FEAR, REALIZE, & BELIEVE – GOD VINDICATES, VENERATES & VALUES

1. FEAR THE HEAVENLY JUDGE MORE THAN EARTHLY PROSECUTORS [GOD VINDICATES] VV.26-27

> Believers should never be afraid of the world because they know God will one day vindicate them.

The world is highly successful at **<u>illusion</u>** & <u>deception</u>. Why should we worry about <u>**unpopularity**</u> in this life when...

The disciple's perspective should be God's perspective.

In God's eternal view He already sees the final outcome of every life.

There are to be no **<u>secrets</u>** in Christianity.

What the Lord has made known to us, we are to make **<u>known</u>** to others.

The world will invariably be offended because it will stand <u>accused</u>.

Unbelievers are offended when told they are <u>sinners</u> under God's judgment & destined for hell.

2. <u>REALIZE</u> GOD KNOWS ABOUT YOUR SUFFERING [GOD VENERATES] V.28

Fear is used here in two senses.

- The first has to do with <u>fright</u> & terror, while
- the second has to do with <u>awe</u> & veneration.

Satan himself cannot touch the **soul**, the **<u>eternal</u>** person.

The lost will not cease to exist, but in their resurrected bodies (Mt.25.46).

A believer is **<u>not</u>** in **<u>danger</u>** of having his soul & body cast into hell - his eternal destiny is heaven.

Reverence of God in His **sovereign** majesty is a powerful motivation for Christians ...

Believers **revered** God more than they feared man during the most intense persecutions.

"They feared man so little because they feared God so much."

3. BELIEVE THAT GOD CARES ABOUT YOUR SUFFERING [GOD VALUES] VV.29-31

Jesus assures the twelve, & all believers that they are <u>dear</u> to their heavenly Father.

How can we be anxious and fearful, knowing of such care & protection by our heavenly Father?
