He.6.13-20

INTRODUCTION:

From Darkness came Light

From Nothing came **Everything** Ge.1.1ff

The Resurrection changes Despair to **Hope** Ge.3.15

The Resurrection changes Death to **Life** I Co.15.19

The Resurrection changes old to **New** II Co.5.17

The Resurrection changes insecurity to **Security**

“trans” (fr. Latin) = “beyond, across, through”

Transformation is the basis for Spiritual Security

def. = “a complete change in the appearance or character of something or someone, especially so that that thing or person is improved.”

Threes Reasons for Security:

I. God’s Promise vv.13-15

❖ Many of God's promises do not depend on our **character** but on his **faithfulness**.

What is keeping us from making spiritual progress?

❖ We do not **apply** ourselves by **faith**.

II. God’s Pledge/Oath vv.16-18

❖ Our salvation is guaranteed by God’s **promise** and God’s oath.

Hebrews is a book of **encouragement** not discouragement.

III God’s Son vv.19-20

❖ Christians have **one** anchor - Jesus Christ our **hope** (Co.1.5; I Ti.1.1)

❖ We are anchored **upward**

❖ We are anchored to move

Our anchor will not **break** – it cannot **slip**

If we start to:

drift from the Word (He.2.1-4), then we also start to

doubt the Word (He.3.7 -4.13). It wont be long when you get

dull towards the Word (He.5.11 – 6.20) &

... and become lazy believers.

CONCLUSION:

The best way to keep from drifting is:

✚ To lay hold of the **anchor**
